

Grade Two Assessment Plan

Throughout the year, I will be assessing the students in a variety of ways. This will include rubrics, checklists, quizzes, spelling tests (word wall check ups), and teacher observations of student participation in various activities such as written tasks, hands on activities and teacher led demonstrations. Your child's assessments will be either sent home or collected within the students' portfolio which will be available for viewing at parent teacher interviews and will be sent home at the end of the year.

I believe communication of student learning is key. Therefore, during the course of the year, if there are any concerns regarding your child's progress, I will contact you through the following forms: notes in the agenda, email, phone calls home, and in person. Please feel free to communicate any concerns with us that you may have about your child.

Communicating Student Learning (CSL)

Students will be assessed on a 1 to 5 scale. If you have any questions regarding this assessment scale, please contact me at the school.

- Term one report cards will be sent home in November 2019.
- Term two report cards will be sent home in March 2020.
- June report cards will be sent home on the last day of school.
